 I, Joseph Wham of Greenville County in the State  
 of South Carolina for and in consideration of one thousand &  
 twenty Dollars and 30 Cents to me paid by Joseph  
 Wham of Greenville County in the State of South Carolina  
 have granted, sold and released and by  
 these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release  
 unto the said Joseph Wham a tract of Land  
 containing one Acre more or less and bounded  
 by Lands of J. R. Harrison M. J. Hawley Marion  
 Abernethy and Miss & Marshall together  
 with all and singular the rights members,  
 Evidences and appurtenances to the said  
 premises belonging or in any wise incident  
 or appertaining to have and to hold all  
 and singular the premises before mentioned  
 unto the said Joseph Wham and his heirs &  
 assigns forever And I do hereby bind my heirs  
 Executors & administrators to warrant & forever  
 defend all and singular the said premises unto  
 the said Joseph Wham and his heirs & assigns  
 against me and my heirs and any other person  
 whomsoever Lawfully claiming or to claim  
 the same or any part thereof Witness my hand  
 and seal this twenty first day of December in the year  
 of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and  
 seventy one and in the thirty six year of the  
 Independence of the United States of America
