 same State and District of which I have granted
 bargain and sold and cleared and these presents do
 witness bargain sell and release unto the said
 Wm. Masters two certain tracts or parcels of land
 one tract lying in Pickens District containing
 Eighty nine Acres more or less being the same grant
 unto D. M. Glenn the sixth day of December 1830 Beginning
 on a line tree on the Saluda River thence to a line
 running S 80 E 33 do to a chestnut corner thence S 75
 W 20 do to a rock thence N 72 W 15 chains 50 links
 to a chestnut thence N 22 W 26 ch to a Spruce pine
 on the Saluda River thence a long the meanders
