 to the custom of Auctions sell and dispose of

 that price the highest bidder for the same  
 Now Therefore this Indenture Witnesseth that the  
 said Samuel A Towns as Commissioner of the  
 said Court under and by virtue of the said  
 decree and in consideration of the sum of  
 Thirty two Dollars paid him by the said John A  
 Towns the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged  
 hath granted Bargained sold and released and  
 by these presents doth grant Bargain sell and release  
 unto the said John A Towns his heirs & assigns  
 all that tract and parcel of Land known and  
 described as the Jordan Malcombs tract or Goodwin  
 tract situate and lying in the upper part  
 of Greenwills District on No-age Mill Creek  
 waters of North Saluda River containing two  
 hundred acres more or less all of which Land  
 is lying and being situate in the District and  
 State aforesaid Together with all and singular  
 the Hereditaments rights members and appurtenances  
 whatsoever to the said Land belonging or in anywise  
 appertaining and the revenues & remainders
