 Sarah A. Southern This Indenture made the 6<sup>th</sup>  
 day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand  
 Eight Hundred and Ninety three between Jas. S. Southern  
 Esquire Sheriff of Greenville County South Carolina of  
 one part and Sarah A. Southern of the other part  
 Witness Thomas William A. McDaniel Notary  
 on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of August in the year  
 of our Lord one thousand eight hundred &  
 ninety three did exhibit his Petition in the Court  
 of Appeals at Greenville Court House in the County  
 of Greenville and State aforesaid against James  
 McWhorter and Barnwell Hunt praying that the  
 said estate of Alexander McWhorter deceased be sold  
 for the payment of the widows debts & the debts of  
 said deceased And the cause being at issue before  
 the Honorable Court aforesaid came on to be heard  
 on the 29<sup>th</sup> day of August in the year of our Lord  
 one thousand eight hundred and ninety three  
 when the said Court after full hearing thereof and  
 mature deliberation in the premises did order  
 Judge and decree that the Real Estate of Alexander  
 McWhorter should be sold at Public Auction by  
 the Sheriff of Greenville County South Carolina on the  
 terms and for the purposes mentioned in the aforesaid  
 order in the said Cause or by reference to the same  
 in the Registers of said Court with appeal And the  
 said J. S. Southern as Sheriff as aforesaid having  
 duly advertised the said tract of land for sale by  
 Public outcry on the sixth day of October in the  
 year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred  
 and ninety three did then openly and publicly  
 and according to the custom of auctions sell  
 and dispose of the said tract of Land as before  
 described unto the said Sarah A. Southern for the  
 sum of fifteen hundred & ninety five Dollars the  
 being at that price the highest bidder for the same  
 Now therefore this Indenture witnesseth that the  
 said J. S. Southern as Sheriff as aforesaid under  
 and by virtue of the said decree and in consideration  
 of the sum of fifteen hundred & ninety five Dollars  
 to him paid by the said Sarah A. Southern the  
 receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath  
 granted bargained sold and released and by this  
 presents doth grant bargain sell and release unto  
 the said Sarah A. Southern her heirs & assigns  
 All that tract of Land situate lying & being  
 in Greenville County on waters of Egg River  
 adjoining lands of Abel Dille Benj. Hall & others

and containing twenty two & one half acres more or less  
 Together with all and singular the rights members  
 Hereditaments and appurtenances to the said tract of  
 Land belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining  
 and the revenues and remainders rents issues and  
 profits thereof and also all the Estate rights tithes  
 Interest Dower possessions property Benefits Charge &  
 demand whatsoever both at Law and in Equity of  
 the Heirs and Representatives of the said Sarah A.  
 Southern and of the parties to this quit and of all  
 other persons rightfully claiming or to claim the same  
 or any part thereof by Law or under them or either  
 of them To have and to hold the said tract of  
 Land with its Hereditaments Privileges & appurtenances  
 unto the said Sarah A. Southern her heirs & assigns  
 to her and her only proper use benefit & comfort  
 forever In witness whereof the said Jas. S. Southern
