 for the sum of one hundred Dollars the being the highest

 Thomas Hopkins of right had of in and to the same
 To Have and to hold the said piece parcel and tract of
 Land with its appurtenances unto the said Lucinda Hopkins
 her and assigns forever as fully and absolutely in & to the said
 John S. Southern might could or ought to grant bargain &
 sell the same by virtue of the Statute aforesaid and the said
 writ of fieri facias or others In witness whereof I the
