The State of South Carolina Whereas I Edwin Ware did on the twentieth day of May in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and sixty two sell and convey unto Mrs Anna Michel the following described lots of land to wit; all those two pieces and lots of land situate lying and being within the incorporate limits of the City of Greenville in the State aforesaid and having respectively the following lines metes and bounds to wit one lot upon the south side of Rudletow street begunning at a Stake 3x upon said Rudletow street and running thence N 64 W with said Street four hundred feet to a Stake at a Street thence S 16 W with said Street four hundred feet to a Stake at a Street thence S 74 E with said Street four hundred feet to a Stake at a Street and thence N 16 E with said Street four hundred feet to the beginning corner And one other Lot South of the former beginning at a Stake at a Street and running thence S 74 E with said Street to a Stake at a Street four hundred feet thence with said Street S 16 W five hundred and thirty five feet to a Stake at M. Persons Land thence N 78 20 W with M. Persons Land four hundred and two feet to a Stake at a Street and thence N 16 E with said Street five hundred and sixty four feet to the beginning corner; the first lot containing three Acres, two Rods and twenty Poles and the second containing five Acres and ten perches. And whereas the said Mrs Anna Michel did on the fifteenth day of October in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and sixty nine sell and convey the same to one Wm J. Fresh who did on the fifteenth day of June in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and seventy one sell and convey the same to Mrs Harriet E. Stradley who is now the owner thereof. And whereas one David Hoke did on the tenth day of June One thousand eight hundred and fifty nine obtain a judgment by confession in the Court of Common Pleas for Greenville County South Carolina against the said Edwin Ware for the sum of Two thousand five hundred and fifty five Dollars which said judgment was duly enrolled and execution issued thereon and the same became and is now a lien upon the above described real estate. And whereas said judgment and execution were on the seventh day of June One thousand eight hundred and sixty three duly transferred assigned

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for value received by Thomas B. Donaldson Administrator of the Estate of said David Hoke to Mrs Lousia Le Bolling And whereas one Hewlet Sullivan did on the thirty first day of October One thousand eight hundred and sixty one obtain a judgment in said Court against said J. Edwin Ware for the sum of three hundred and twenty five Dollars and twenty cents which judgment was also duly enrolled and execution thereon issued and the same also became a Lien upon the aforesaid Real estate, and whereas said last mentioned judgment and execution were also assigned to said Mrs Lousia Le Bolling for value received on the eleventh day of March eight hundred and seventy four by said Hewlet Sullivan and said Lousia Le Bolling is now the sole owner of both said judgments and executions Now Know all men by these presents that the said Lousia Le Bolling for and in consideration of the sum of Three hundred Dollars to me paid by the aforesaid Mrs Harriet E. Stradley, have renounced released and forever relinquish unto the said Mrs Harriet E. Stradley and by these presents do renounce release and forever relinquish unto the said Mrs Harriet E. Stradley her heirs and assigns forever all the right title interest and estate legal or equitable, present or future which I now have or may hereafter have of in or to all and singular the premises above described by reason of the liens of said judgments or either of them hereby for myself my heirs executors and administrators warranting the title to all and singular the said premises unto the said Mrs Harriet E.
