 Know all men by these presents that Emily Rowland of Greenville District in the said State in consideration of the sum of three thousand two hundred and fifty dollars to me paid by Hamlin Beattie of Greenville District in the State of said have granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain, sell and release unto the said Hamlin Beattie all that certain lot of land situate in the Town of Greenville on the Buncombe Road beginning at a stake on said Road at the corner of John Lovelands lot thence N 33 W 200 feet to a stake thence S 22 W 300 feet to a stake thence S 38 E 200 feet to a stake thence S 22 E to the beginning corner, it being the same lot conveyed by John W Prop to Thomas R Rowland as also that other lot of land adjoining, beginning at a stake on Rowland Street and corner of the olive lot and runs with said Street 331 feet to a stake thence S 7 E with West Street 130 feet to a stake on J R Benedicts corner thence N 23 1/2 E 232 feet with said Benedicts line to a stake thence N 33 W 200 feet to the beginning corner as conveyed to Thomas R Rowland by Nancy M.  This indenture made the fifth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty eight between D Stobo Farrow Esq Commissioner of the Honorable Court of Equity for Spartanburg District at Spartanburg Court House in the said State of the one part and Columbus Mills of the other part; whereas D Stobo Farrow and Nancy R Mills Admrs and Mary S Lurston on or about the fifteenth day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty eight did exhibit their Bill of Complaint in the Court of Equity at Spartanburg Court House in the said State against Richard P Mills of Columbus Mills & others paying among other things for the sale of the Rebel Estate of Green Mills deceased, all of which will more fully appear by reference to the pleadings in said case on file in the Commissioners office for the aforesaid District and the cause being at issue before the Honorable Court, came or to be heard at three o'clock in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty eight when the said Court, after full hearing thereof, and mature deliberation in the premises, did order, adjudge and decree that the tract of land below described and other Real Estate described in the aforesaid pleadings should be sold at Public Auction, by the Commissioner of the said Court, on the terms and for the purposes mentioned in their Secretal order as by reference thereto in the registry of the said Court will appear and the said D Stobo Farrow as Commissioner of the said Court, after having advertised the said tract of land for sale by public outcry on the fifth day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty eight did they openly and publicly according to the custom of Auctioneers and in the
