 to hold all and singular the premises before
 mentioned unto the said George W. Mearns his
 heirs and assigns forever and do hereby
 bind myself my heirs executors and admi-
 nistrators to warrant and forever defend all
 and singular the said premises unto the said
 George W. Mearns his heirs and assigns against
 myself and my heirs and every other person
 whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the
