To have and to hold the above granted premises unto him the said William Wynne his heirs and assigns forever. Together with all and singular the rights members and hereditaments and appurtenances therunto belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining and to the said Jerry Wynne do hereby bind myself my heirs and assigns forever to warrant and defend the above granted premises unto him the said William Wynne his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs and assigns and against any and every other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.  This indenture made the
 fifteenth day of May in the year of our Lord One
 thousand Eight hundred and seventy five, between Wil-
 liam A. McDaniel Esquire Clerk of the Honorable
 Court for Greenville County at Greenville
 Court House in the said State of the one part and
 John H. Dean of the other part, whereas Equival Westfield
 as administratrix of the goods, Chattels
 and so forth which were of John Westfield deces-
 ed on or about the seventeenth day of July in the
 year of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred
 and twenty four Exhibited her Bill of Complaint
 in the Circuit Court at Greenville Court House
 in the State against Mary Westfield John H.
 Westfield, Thomas M. Lee, George S. Soper, Henry
 Le. Markley and Edward H. Stokes for the purposes
 of Marshalling the Assets of her testators Estate and
 distribution Settlement of said Estate and so forth
 and the cause being at issue before the Honorable
 Court on the twenty fifth day of August Anno
 Domini One thousand Eight hundred and seventy
 four, it was referred to James H. Whitner as
 Special Referee and thereafter to wit on the
 fourteenth day of May Anno Domini One thou-
 sand eight hundred and seventy five the said
 Court after the coming in of the report of said
 Special Referee after a full hearing thereof
 and mature deliberation in the premises did an-
 amongst other things order, adjudged and decree that
 upon John H. Dean paying the said Clerk the
 sum of Five Hundred and Sixty Dollars the
 same being the balance of the purchase money
