Gosnell of Greenville County and State aforesaid for in consideration of the sum of One hundred and fifty Dollars to me in hand paid by Charles Gosnell and Francis R. Burrell of the County & State aforesaid I do hereby bargain sell and forever release to the said Charles Gosnell and Francis R. Burrell their lifetimes after their death to Thomas C. Burrell all that tract of Land lying and being in County and State aforesaid lying on the north of Hog Back Mountain on the Waters of Mill Creek a Branch Waters of South People's River Beginning on a Stake 37 on a Branch thence N 78 3/4 Chains to a Poplar 37 thence N 86 E 16 ch to a Chestnut Oak 37 thence N 71 E 31 ch to a maple 37 thence S 79 E 65 ch to a Chestnut Oak 37 thence N 77 E 18 ch to a Chestnut Oak 37 on a below line thence with said line to the Branch thence up said Branch to the Beginning corner this Branch being a conditional line between Gosnell and Burrell supposed by estimation to contain One hundred Acres more or less Together with all the hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining to the same premises or in anywise incident to have and to hold to the said Charles Gosnell & Francis R. Burrell their lifetimes then to Thomas C. Burrell. I do hereby bind myself my heirs my Executor Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises against me my heirs or Executors Administrators or assigns and against any other person or persons whatsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof Witness my hand and seal this August the seventh of the year of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and seventy five

J. H. Ware Jr To Deed The State of South Carolina Greenville County Know all men by these presents that J. H. Ware Jr of the County of Greenville and State aforesaid for and in consideration of the natural love and affection which I bear to my beloved wife Anna Ware and of the children of her body by me begotten and in the further consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars to me paid by her the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have given granted bargained sold and delivered and by these presents do give grant bargain sell and deliver unto the said Anna Ware and my said children all that tract or parcel of land situated lying and being in the County of Greenville and State aforesaid Commencing at an Oak 37 m. on Long Branch and running thence N 58 E 21 1/2 to Red Oak 37 thence N 27 3/4 W 38 1/4 to a Stone 37 m. on W. McLanahan's corner thence S 58 1/2 W 38 08 to a Stone 37 v. m. thence S 58 3/4 W 20 00 to a Post Oak 37 on Cleveland land thence S 44 1/2 E 30 08 to a Red Oak 37 on a small Branch thence down the said small branch to Long Branch thence down the said Long Branch to the beginning corner and containing One hundred and sixty three Acres more or less as will more fully appear by plat of J. V. Siphume Surveyor made on the 21 day of July 1874 being the same tract of land conveyed to me by Mrs Anna J. Irvine by Deed dated 23 day of April 1874 and Recorded in Book F F page 397. Also all that tract or parcel of Land situated lying and being in the said County and State on both sides of the White Horse Road Beginning at a Post Oak on a Choice line and running N 48 1/2 E with the said Choice line 16 1/8 to a Red Oak 37 thence N 44 W till by a straight line running S 55 1/2 W will pass a Stake on the White Horse Road and on the West of said Road to Black Oak Stump 37 and thence S 31 E 12 to the beginning corner containing forty three and three fourths Acres more or less being the same lot of land
