Branch water of Salsada River adjoining lands of Capt. James Payne on the North West, and said Mrs. Henrietta Shovelley on the South West End, Beginning at Stone 37 37 rods, near the School or Church thence S 8 1/2 E 38 1/2 to Stone 37 37 rods on old line thence N 1/4 W 4 9/4 chs to Stone 37 37 rods on old line thence S 1/4 W 3 1/6 chs to the Beginning Stone 37 37 rods reference to a Plat Herewith annexed made by W. D. Threlkeld D.S., will more fully appear. Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident, or appertaining, to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Henry Kissel, Sawney Westfield and David Richardson, Trustees of the Golden Grove Chapel of the Methodist Episcopal Church and their successors in office forever, Reserving the right to change the road at my own discretion and the Church not to be used for anything but school and Church purposes, and I do hereby bind myself, my heirs, Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Henry Kissel, Sawney Westfield and David Richardson, Trustees of the said Golden Grove Chapel of the Methodist Episcopal Church and their successors in office Reserving the right to change the road at my own discretion and the Church not to be used for anything but school and Church purposes. Against myself and my heirs, and against every person or persons whatsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof Reserving the right to change the road at my own discretion and the Church not to be used for anything but school and Church purposes.
