 dred and five Dollars being at that price the highest  
 bid for the same. Now know all men that I the said  
 J. L. Southern Sheriff in consideration of the premises  
 and also in consideration of this sum of six hundred  
 and five Dollars paid me by the said John W. Bram-  
 lett the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have  
 granted bargained sold and released and by these pres-  
 ents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said  
 John W. Bramlett and his heirs and assigns all that  
 certain piece parcel and tract of Land situate in Greenvi-  
 lle County and State aforesaid on South Tiger River  
 adjoining lands of Aquatus Sew James Nesbitt John  
 M. Bailey J. W. Bramlett and others and containing
