 Book 104 Page 545 This deed is not to take effect
 until my death then to take possession and enjoy
 the rents and profits during my natural lifetime
 and at my death to go to my said before mentioned
 children equally in fee simple if any of my
 said children should die before myself then
 the Equal share of said children shall go to
 those living at my death should either of them
 die leaving a child or children the child or chil-
 dren to represent the father or mother and to
 have the share of the deceased Together with all
 and singular the rights members hereditaments and
 appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in
 anywise incident or appertaining To have and to
 hold all and singular the said premises before men-
 tioned unto the said Mary Ladsen King Gordon
 Roscius Gordon and Jane Gordon their heirs and
 assigns forever with the incumbrances and limi-
 tations herein before expressed and I do
 hereby bind my heirs executors and administrators
 to warrant and forever defend all and singular
 the said premises unto the said Mary Ladsen
 King Gordon Roscius Gordon and Jane Gordon
 their heirs and assigns against he and my heirs
 and all other lawfully claiming or to claim
 the same or any part thereof
