

In Bankruptcy

Known all men by these presents that W. W. Vance, Esq. for South Carolina in the District aforesaid has been duly appointed in the matter. Now therefore I William J. Lawson one of the Registrars in Bankruptcy of said Court, by virtue of the authority vested in me, by the fourteenth section of the said act of Congress entitled "an act to establish a uniform system of Bankruptcy throughout the United States" approved March 2, 1867 do hereby convey and assign to the said W. W. Vance, Esq. assignee do aforesaid, all the Estate real and personal, of the said Austin & Shovelley Bankruptcy aforesaid including both as a firm & individually all the property of whatever kind of which they were possessed or in which they were interested, or entitled to have, on the 10 day of May 1875 with all their Deeds Books and papers relating thereto, excepting such property as is exempted from the operation of this assignment, by the provisions of the said fourteenth section of said act. To have and to hold all the foregoing premises to the said W. W. Vance, Esq. his heirs forever, in trust nevertheless, for the use and purposes with the powers and subject to the conditions and limitations set forth in said act.
