Sudduth & Samuel Craun & others together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Tract of land belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining; and the reversions and remainders rents issues and profits thereof; and also all the Estate right title interest Power possession property Benefit Claim and demand whatsoever both at law and in Equity of the heirs and representatives of the said Providence Dill and of the parties to this suit and of all other persons right fully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. From or under them or either of them: To have and to hold the said tract of land with its hereditaments privileges and appurtenances unto the said Solomon Dill his heirs and assigns to his and his only proper use benefit and behoof forever.
