hereby acknowledge that we have
unduly fence a strip of land in the City of Greenville, belonging
to the Estate of Vardny McBee dec'd situate between our lots of
what is known as the Innie Spring lot, and is Thirty feet
said Avenue St and Broad St by three hundred and forty
six feet, from one to the other - which said strip of land
Thirty by Three hundred & forty six feet we bargained for
several years since & failed to pay for, & hence acknowledge
that we only hold the same as tenants at will of the Exors of
the said Vardny McBee & agree to remove the fence at
any time within ten days after notice to do so
