The State of South Carolina  
Known all manner by these presents,  
That I Mary Taylor of Green-  
ville County in the Stateforeaid in consideration of the sum  
of Four Hundred Dollars to me in hand paid at and before  
the sealing of these presents, by Thomas W Davis in the State  
aforesaid Palmettoft whereof is hereby acknowledged I have  
granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do  
grant at bargain sell and release unto the said Thomas W Davis  
all that tract of land lying and being in the County of Greenville  
and State aforesaid some few miles East of the City of Greenville  
and three miles from Greys Station on the Air Line Railroad  
on Branch Waters of Eocene River, containing twenty two  
acres, be the same more or less having the following boundaries  
to wit: Beginning at a stone 37 on a Branch thence 18 39  
111' 31 to a Post Oak x 3 thence 18 1 4 110 2 50 to a stone  
x 3 thence 18 56 8 10,00 to a stone x 3 thence 18 6 2 1/2 E 13,50  
to a stone x 3 thence 8 4 2 E 5,60 to a stone x 3 thence 18 6 3 1/2  
E 10,00 to a stone x 3 thence 8 5 8 E 18 7 to stones on the Branch  
thence with the said Branch to the beginning corner on  
said Branch see plat hereto annexed for same descrip-  
tion by J. C. C. and Surveyor. Together with all and  
singular the rights numbers herdements and appurtenances  
to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appur-  
tenant, To have and to hold all and singular the said  
premises before mentioned unto the said Thomas W Davis his  
heirs & assigns forever, and I do hereby bind my heirs  
executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend  
all and singular the said premises unto the said Thomas  
W Davis his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs  
and all others lawfully claiming or to claim the same
