Know all men by these presents that I
William J Gibson Trustee of Martha E Whilden, the wife of H
Furman Whilden, of Greenville County of the State aforesaid, the
aforesaid Martha E Whilden consenting to the same and
by her signature in the presence of witnesses publicly decla-
ring her consent in consideration of the sum of Six hundred
and fifty Dollars to me paid by the City Council of
Greenville have granted bargained sold and released and
by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the
said City Council of Greenville all that lot or parcel of
land situate and being in the District and State aforesaid and
also within the corporate limits of the City of Greenville
said lot being bounded on the one side by Main Street on
the opposite side by Elford Street and by land belong-
ing to the colored school; on the third side by land
known as Mrs Bess Tanyard, on the fourth side being bound-
ed by lands belonging to Capt. Williams and the Public
Grave Yard containing chevquiers more or less and
generally known as Col. E J Elford's Spring Place
Together with all and singular the rights incidents heredita-
ments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging
or in anywise incident or appertaining; To have and to hold
all and singular the premises aforesaid unto the said
City Council of Greenville their heirs and assigns forever
and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and ad-
ministrators to warrant and forever defend all and sing-
ular the said premises unto the said City Council of
Greenville their heirs and assigns against myself my heirs
and every other person or persons lawfully claiming or
to claim the same or any part thereof;
