Know all men by these presents that I W D Goodwin of the State of South Carolina Greenville County in consideration of the sum of Two hundred Dollars to me paid by Alfred Fuller of same state & County the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained sold and quit claimed and by these presents do grant bargain sell and quit claim unto the said Alfred Fuller his heirs and assigns forever all my right title and interest in and to all that certain tract or piece of land situated on the North side of the Spartanburg road one and half miles from Greenville Co SC adjoining lands of John McGowan Mr Morris and A E Stone and others containing Eight Acres commencing at a Post oak 37 m on the north side of the Spartanburg road said road thence along the road N 72° E 8.75 to Post oak 37 m thence m 35° 06' 1.29 to Red oak Morris corner thence N 67 1/2 W with Morris line 19.55 to Stone 37 m in Morris line thence S 30 1/2 E 8.25 to Large white oak just below the spring thence S 42° E 6.13 to the beginning corner with all and singular the Peres elements and appurtenances thereto belonging do witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal 29<sup>th</sup> day of June in the year 1866 and for a true and correct copy of the original thereof
