Kilgore in Trust for the sole use and benefit of myself Jesse C. Kilgore and my Family and whereas the said Jesse C. Kilgore desires to convey a part of said Trust to my daughter Mary J. D. Kilgore so that she may enjoy the benefit of my Trust Estate in the land hereafter more particularly described for and during my lifetime. Now therefore know all men by these presents that I the said Jesse C. Kilgore for and in consideration of the love and affection I have and bear for my said daughter Mary J. D. Kilgore and for divers other causes and considerations me therunto moving and for and in consideration of the sum of Five Dollars to me in hand paid by my said daughter Mary J. D. Kilgore have granted bargained sold released and relinquished and by these presents do grant bargain sell release and relinquish unto the said Mary J. D. Kilgore all my right title and trust Estate in all that certain piece parcel or tract of land containing One hundred sixty eight and one half acres more or less situate in Greenville County State aforesaid on both sides of Peter's Creek branch waters of Eumeces River beginning on a Pine on the road leading to Anderson's Bridge and running thence N 51° W 11.03 chains to a stone 3x3 on said road thence S 75 3/4° E 15.68 chains to a P.O. 3x3 in field thence S 46° E 13.30 chains to a stone 3x3 at corner of fence thence N 62 3/4° E 17.30 chains to a stone 3x3 thence S 46 3/4° E 34.50 chains to a stone 3x3 thence S 35° W 22.71 chains to a P.O. 3x3 cut down thence S 10 1/2° W 17.50 chains to a white oak 3x3 on
