Know all men by these presents that I Whitner Symms of Greenville County in the State aforesaid, in consideration of Two thousand Dollars to me paid by Laura A Steele of Greenville County in the State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Laura A Steele all that lot piece or parcel of land lying being and situate in the City of Greenville County and State aforesaid commencing at a Stake on Westfield Street running thence N 70 $\frac{3}{4}$  W Six hundred and fifty three feet and two fifths of one foot to Stake on lands belonging to Estate of John Westfield, decd thence S 19 $\frac{1}{2}$  W two hundred feet to Stake thence S 70 $\frac{3}{4}$  E Six hundred and fifty three feet and two fifths of one foot to Stake on Westfield Street thence N 19 $\frac{1}{2}$  E two hundred feet to the beginning corner containing three acres more or less all of which is more minutely described in plat of same made in pursuance of an order of Court by H. P. Johnson and J. D. Southern Surveyors dated January 21st 1876 bounded by lands belonging to Estate of John Westfield decd and Westfield Street

Together with all and singular the rights liberties hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Laura A Steele her heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Laura A Steele her heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and every other person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
