Bolling to Dr. Thomas Lake deceased and better known as the Wells lot together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining, To have and to hold all and singular the said premises before mentioned unto the said Mary Jane Lake her heirs and assigns forever, and we do hereby bind ourselves our heirs executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Mary Jane Lake her heirs and assigns against ourselves and our heirs and all others lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
