 of and such portion of said Wall, as either of said parties or
 their respective heirs shall or may use as a party Wall and
 that whenever said party Wall or any portion thereof shall
 be rebuilt it shall be erected on the same spot where it
 now stands, and be of the same size and same or similar
 materials and of like quality. It is further mutually
 agreed between the said parties that this agreement shall be
 perpetual but no part of the fee in that half of the Land
 occupied by said Wall, which belongs to said H. C. Mark,
 shall pass to or be vested in the said W. C. Currie his heirs
 or assigns by virtue of these presents.
