do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Thomas  
Howell a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being  
in the State and District aforesaid commencing on a Rose  
mill on the Augusta Road and running thence S 81 W  
15 or to a Rock on another Road known as the Mahaffey  
Road thence along and with said Road about S 34  
W 45 to a Rock on an old line thence S 40 E 50 to stake  
on thence S 82 E 14 75 to stake on on the aforesaid Augusta  
Road thence up the said Road 11 or chains to the beginning  
in State containing Twenty Acres more or less  
To have with all and singular the rights members  
hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging  
or in anywise incident or appertaining, to have  
and to hold all and singular the said premises unto the  
said Thomas Howell his heirs and assigns forever, and we  
do hereby bind ourselves and our heirs Executors and  
administrators unto the said Thomas Howell his  
heirs and assigns against ourselves our heirs and aga-  
inst all other persons or persons whomsoever  
lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part
