 and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release
 unto the said Thomas G Gower and Whitner Symmes all that
 lot or parcel of land lying being and situate in the City
 of Greenville County and State aforesaid commencing at a
 stake in Mulberry Street running thence S 55 W three chains
 and sixteen links to Stake thence S 35 E three chains
 and sixteen links to Stake thence N 35 E three chains and
 sixteen links to the beginning Stake containing one acre
 being the lot of land whereon now live E. H. Gilmore Mr.
 Summers & Charles Alexander's lots all adjoining
 the same, Together with all and singular the rights
 members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said
 premises belonging or in any wise incident or apper-
 taining To have and to hold all and singular the prem-
 ises before mentioned unto the said Thomas G
 Gower and Whitner Symmes their heirs and assigns
 forever. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors
 and administrators to warrant and forever defend all
 and singular the said premises unto the said Thomas
 G Gower and Whitner Symmes their heirs and assigns aga-
 inst me and my heirs and every other person whom-
 soever lawfully claiming, or to claim the same or any
 part thereof,
