before mentioned unto the said G. P. and Marinda  
Rarrison their heirs and assigns forever, Cued do  
hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators  
to warrant and forever defend all and singular  
the said premises unto the said G. P. and Marinda Rar-  
ison their heirs and assigns against myself and  
my heirs & all others lawfully claiming or to claim  
the same or any part thereof
