 Laurens Newberry Richland Union York in the State of South
 Carolina and in any other places, that same to be held and enjoy-
 ed by the said S. C. Dickson for his own use and behoof
 and for the use and behoof of his legal representatives or assigns
 to the full end of the term of Seventeen years from date of
 said Letters Patent as fully and entirely as the same would have
 been held and enjoyed by had this sale ever been made,
 and the purchaser hereof admits that the sole and only induc-
 ment which has influenced or induced him to make such
 purchase is a personal examination of the article patented
 and what he deems its merits, wholly uninfluenced by any
 statements or representations made by the vendor or their
 agent or agents, or any of them, and it is understood by the
 Vendor that no agent or agents of the vendor are author-
 ized, but strictly forbidden, to make any statements in
 reference to said article, or its merits, except such as
 are contained and embraced in this deed, and this pur-
 chase and sale is made with a full knowledge and un-
 derstanding of such facts by the vendor, and this sale
 is effected in accordance therewith.
