McAdew, A. S. Buford, David Frauberger, and the United States Security Company, were defendants, it was among other things ordered, adjudged and decreed, that the said above recited decree of the Circuit Court of the United States for the Northern District of Georgia be, and the same thereby was confirmed, and ordered to stand as the judgment and decree of the said Circuit Court of the United States for the Western District of North Carolina so far as concerned the portion of the railway and other property of the said Atlanta & Richmond Air Line Railway Company granted by the said deed of trust, which was situated in the State of North Carolina, and that the sale and conveyance directed by the said decree of the Circuit Court of the United States for the Northern District of Georgia, would, so far as concerned such portion of the said railway and other property, communicate to the purchasers thereof, a good and absolute title to the same, free and clear of all claim thereto, or therein, by or on the part of the defendants in the said suit pending in the said Circuit Court of the United States for the Western District of North Carolina and each and every of them, and of all persons claiming by, from or under them or either of them. And whereas by a decree of the Circuit Court of the United States for the District of North Carolina made and entered on the day of October eighteen hundred and seventy six, in a certain cause pending therein (also auxiliary to that pending before the said Circuit Court of the United States for the Northern District of Georgia) in which the said Shilworth Wilmer and Auguste Richard were complainants, and the said Atlanta & Richmond Air Line Railway Company, the Richmond & Danville Railroad Company, Rufus W. McAdew, A. S. Buford, M. A. Strubling and the United States Security Company were defendants, it was, among other things ordered, adjudged and decreed, that the said above recited decree of the Circuit Court of the United States for the Northern District of Georgia, be, and the same thereby was confirmed, and ordered to stand as the judgment and decree of the said Circuit Court of the United States for the District of North Carolina so far as concerned the portion of the railway and other property of the said Atlanta & Richmond Air Line Railway Company granted by the said deed of trust which was situated in the State of North Carolina, and that a sale and conveyance as directed by the said decree would, so far as concerned such portion of said Railway and other property, communicate to the purchasers thereof, a good and absolute title to the same, free and clear of all claim thereto or therein, by or on the part of the defendants in the said cause before the Circuit Court of the United States for the District of North Carolina and each and every of them, and of all persons claiming
