of an act of the Legislature, entitled an act for establishing the mode of granting the lands now vacant in this State, and for allowing a commutation to be received for some lands that have been granted, passed the 19th day of February 1791 we have granted and by these presents do grant unto Ezekiel Burns his heirs and assigns, a plantation or tract of Land, containing twelve and one half Acres situate in Abbeville County and State aforesaid near the head branches of Enore River and bounded by lines running S E by W A Williams Land and N W by Mathew Darters Land and S W, by Marchants Land and having such shape form and marks, as are represented by a plat herewith annexed, together with all woods trees water courses profits Commodities, appurtenances and hereditaments whatsoever thereunto belonging: To have and to hold the said tract of land Twelve and one half acres of land, and all and singular, other the premises hereby granted to the said Ezekiel Burns his heirs and assigns forever in free and Common Socage
