

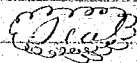

Know all men by these presents, that
 Whitner Symmes of Greenville City, South Carolina, in the
 District aforesaid, has been duly appointed assignee in said
 matter. Now, therefore, I, William S. Lawson, one of the
 Registers in Bankruptcy of said Court, by virtue of the
 authority vested in me, by the fourteenth section of the act
 of Congress entitled "an act to establish a uniform system
 of Bankruptcy throughout the United States" approved March
 2, 1867 do hereby convey and assign to the said Whitner
 Symmes assignee as aforesaid, all the estate, real and personal
 of the said James M. Mahaffey Bankrupt aforesaid, including
 all the property of whatsoever kind of which he was possessor
 or in which he was interested, or entitled to have on the 19 day
 of April 1877 with all his debts, books and papers relating
 thereto. Excepting such property as is excepted from the operation
 of of this assignment, by the provisions of the said section
 of said act. To have and to hold, all the foregoing prop-
 erty to the said Whitner Symmes his heirs forever,
 in trust, nevertheless, for the use and purposes, with the powers
 and subject to the conditions and limitations set forth in said
 act. In testimony whereof I the said Register have hereunto
 set my hand and caused to be affixed the seal of the
 said Court, this 8 day of June A.D. 1877.
