I have said to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said William Mitchell his heirs and assigns and I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors administrators towards and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said William Mitchell his heirs and assigns forever and against myself my heirs and every other person or persons who lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.
