the same may in any wise concern, S. J. Douthett Judge of Probate for the County of Greenville in the said State and greeting; Whereas Micajah B. Harrison, J. W. Harrison, J. Henry Harrison, Idas & Mauldin Ballie Harrison and Wade H. Harrison on or about the 5<sup>th</sup> day of October 1875 did exhibit their Petition in the Court of Probate at Greenville Court House in the County of Greenville and State of aforesaid, against Thomas G. Harrison and Anna M. Harrison, and the cause being at issue before the Honorable Court aforesaid, came on to be heard on the day of

when the said Court after full hearing thereof, and mature deliberation, in the premises, did order, adjudge and Decree that the tracts of land belonging to the estate of Nancy Harrison deceased hereinafter mentioned and described, should be vested in Wade H. Harrison, at the sum of three thousand one hundred Dollars the appraised value of the same.

Now know all men, that the said S. J. Douthett Judge of Probate of Greenville County, in consideration of the premises, and also in consideration of the sum of three thousand one hundred Dollars, paid over by the said Wade H. Harrison the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain

sell and release unto the said Wade H. Harrison his heirs and assigns all that tract of land situate lying and being in the County of Greenville and State aforesaid, adjoining lands of Joseph W. Sullivan, R. W. Shumate and others, and containing One hundred and sixty eight Acres more or less and known in the division in this case as tract

no. reference being had to the Plat made by Deputy Surveyor J. Dun-

Klin Sullivan will more fully show. Also all that tract of land situate lying and being in the County of Greenville in the State aforesaid adjoining lands of John Peden, William Choice and others, and containing One hundred and eighty acres more or less, known

as tract No. 11 in said division, reference being had to the Plat made by J. DunKlin Sullivan Deputy Surveyor will more fully show

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever, to the said tracts of land belonging or in anywise appertaining, and the revenues and remainders, rents issues and profits thereof, And also all the estate right title interest devise possession property, benefit claim and demand whatsoever both
