To have and to hold the same against me and my heirs and any one else claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof to him the said C. B. Tarrant and his heirs forever.

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Whereas Deedator to Bennett executed to Samuel Stradley on the thirteenth day of April in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and seventy four a certain mortgage of Real Estate where by he authorized and empowered the said Samuel Stradley his heirs executors administrators and assigns upon the non-payment of a debt mentioned in and secured by said mortgage to advertise and sell at public outcry the premises hereinafter described and upon such sale to execute to the purchaser or purchasers his heirs their heirs or assigns a good and sufficient title in the law, all of which will more fully and at large appear upon reference to said mortgage which recorded in the office of the register of mens conveyance for Greenville County South Carolina in Mortgage Book to page 29 and whereas said debt was not paid at maturity and has not been paid since where by said powers became operative and said premises were duly advertised and were sold at public
