Kelly the other tested the nineteenth day of September in the year of our Lord One thousand Eight hundred and seventy three at the suit of J. W. Coleman to me directed commanding me that of the goods and chattels lands and tenements of John Bates Jr to levy the sum of One thousand and sixty five Dollars damages and costs, I have seized and taken of the lands and tenements of the said John Bates Jr all that certain piece parcel and tract of land containing two hundred acres more or less situate in the
