Know all men by these presents that J Hoahm of Greenville in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of six hundred Dollars to me paid by Jacob Eulow of Greenville in the State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Jacob Eulow all that tract or parcel of land situate Greenville County and State aforesaid containing one hundred and sixty four and three fourth acres more or less being the same land bounded Wm Chovrae to said J Hoahm (beginning at a stake in the Ashville Road thence up said Road to a B O. and on the right of said road thence N 1/4 W E 35.10 to a Chest Oak & on at History House thence S 30 1/4 E 49 chs to a Chest Oak thence S 10 1/8 W 11, 15 chs to a stake thence S 88 3/4 W 31, 80 chs to stake thence N 68 3/4 W 3, 40 to the beginning & and bounded by lands of Marchbanks Patson said Hoahm and said Ashville Road

Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in any wise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Jacob Eulow his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and administrators to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Jacob Eulow his heirs and assigns against me and my heirs and every other person whatsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
