Feaster Trustee an undivided four fifths interest of, in or to all that piece parcel and tract of land situate lying and being in the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina known as the S. B. McLehannan home place less forty and one half acres deeded to Elizabeth Johnson on the nineteenth day of April 1877.
