McClanahan dated the fifth day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty five, and recorded in Book A A of the office of the Register of Meuse Conveyances for Greenville County South Carolina pages 455 & 456. The four thousand dollars consideration money above mentioned being the whole of the trust fund. And I do hereby bind myself my heirs executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Annette G. Feaster Trustee as aforesaid her successors, heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs every other person lawfully claiming, or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
