127 1/2 A= three tracts of land, all situate in the County of Greenville to wit tract No 1 about three miles from Greenville S. C. on the north side of the Laurens Road Beginning at a P.O. corner on the South side of said Road and running thence N 12 1/2 E 46.69 chs to a Rock 3x thence N 11 1/2 E 3.50 chs to a rock 3x on Pike road thence along said Road to a Stone 3x thence S 12 3/4 W 63.62 chs to a Rock 3x on Laurens Road thence along said Road to the Beginning corner containing one hundred and twenty two and one half Acres more or less - and bounded by lands of Wm Goldsmith, John W. Stokes, J. H. Vaughan & others - To wit tract No 2 - about three miles from Greenville S.
