 To all to whom these presents shall come: I Perry D. Gilreath, Sheriff of Greenville County, and State aforesaid and greeting: whereas by virtue of a writ of Fieri Facias issued out of the Court of Common Pleas, held for the County of Greenville, tested the first day of December in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and seventy six at the suit of Whitfield Powers vs to me directed, commanding me, that of the goods and chattels lands and tenements of A. J. Reeves & son to levy the sum of Two hundred and sixty two \$00 Dollars damages and costs, I have seized and taken of the lands and tenements of the said A. J. Reeves & son all that certain piece parcel and tract of land containing Ten acres more or less, situate and being in the County of Greenville, in the State aforesaid One and a half miles from Greenville Co. on Spartanburg Road, and bounded by lands of Rev. Samuel Green Col. Fuller and others And whereas the said premises with their appurtenances, since the seizure by me made, by virtue of the said writ of Fieri Facias before mentioned, have been exposed to sale at public vendue, and purchased by Julius C. Smith of the County of Greenville in the State of South Carolina for the sum Two hundred and thirty Dollars being the highest sum that was bid therefor.
