Deed

The State of South Carolina  
Knows all men by these presents  
that we Namie le Goldsmith  
and William Goldsmith of Green

wille County, in the State aforesaid in consideration of Fifty five hundred and thirty eight Dollars to us paid by John H. Houston of Charleston County in the State aforesaid, have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said John H. Houston all those two certain pieces parcels and lots of land situate lying and being in said County of Greenville, and said State, about one and three quarter miles from Greenville Court House, on both sides of the Laurens Road, adjoining lands of Goldsmith, Bees and Glenn, and having the following lines, metes and bounds: - to wit: Lot No. 1 - beginning at a stake in the centre of the Laurens Road, and running thence S 62 W 84, 50 chs to a stake thence S 37 E 14, 75 chs to a stake thence N 52 E 37, 25 chs to a stake in the centre of said Laurens Road, thence N 58 W 9 chs to the beginning, containing forty two and 4/10 acres more or less, and Lot No. 2 beginning at stake in the centre of the Laurens Road, and running thence N 37 1/2 E 10, 20 chs to a stake; thence N 66 3/4 E 16, 25 chs to a stone; thence N 25 W 2 chs to a stone; thence S 66 3/4 W 29, 75 chs to a stake in the centre of the said Laurens road, Bees's corner thence S 58 E 2, 50 chs along the centre of said road to the beginning, containing eight and 1/3 acres (8 1/3) more or less being portions of tract conveyed to W. le Goldsmith by B. Maully Jr 1<sup>st</sup> January 1872 - & by said W. le to N. le Goldsmith 13 January 1877 Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said John H. Houston his heirs and assigns forever and we do hereby bind us our heirs executors and administrators
