Freeman full that price, parcel or lot of land being parcels of the lands above mentioned - situate and lying in the City and County of Greenville, in the State aforesaid being at the S West corner of Henderson's lot on Washington Street thence along said street N 50° W two hundred and forty three feet and one fourth of one foot to an Iron pin corner of street, thence N 4 1/2° W one hundred and twenty seven feet to a stake on street thence S 94 1/2° E two hundred and twenty feet and one half of one foot to a stake thence S 55° W three feet and one half of one foot to the beginning corner containing one fourth of one acre more or less bounded by Washington Street formerly lot of Bram Brian Henderson & others Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances, to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said Alice E. Freeman her heirs and assigns forever freed from and discharged of all further trusts whatsoever, And we do hereby bind ourselves, our heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular the said premises unto the said Alice E.
