of Mrs Susan W Smith of Greenville District in the State  
 aforesaid in consideration of Three thousand Dollars (\$3000)  
 to me paid by Nathan Whitmore of Newberry District  
 in the State aforesaid have granted bargained sold and  
 released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and  
 release unto the said Nathan Whitmore all that lot of  
 land containing eight acres, two rods and thirteen  
 perches, lying on the Augusta Road near the town of  
 Greenville and bounded by the Augusta Road, and lands  
 of Dr W W Pusley The Furman University and Ellis  
 Benson being the same lot of land described and con-  
 veyed in a deed from Waddy Thompson to myself  
 bearing date the 28<sup>th</sup> day of September A.D. 1846  
 Together with all and singular the rights members hereditam-  
 ents and appurtenances to the said premises belonging  
 or in any wise incident or appertaining, To have and to hold  
 all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto  
 the said Nathan Whitmore his heirs and assigns  
 forever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs exec-  
 utors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend  
 all and singular the said premises, unto the said Nathan  
 Whitmore his heirs and assigns, against myself and my  
 heirs and against every other person whomsoever law-  
 fully claiming, or to claim the same, or any part thereof,  
 Witness my hand and seal this twenty seventh day of  
 June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hun-  
 dred and fifty three and in the 77<sup>th</sup> year of the Indep-  
 endence of the United States of America
