enville in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of One Hundred and sixty and ninety five one hundredth Dollars to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by James H. Black of the County of Greenville in the State aforesaid (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted bargained sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said James H. Black all that lot or parcel of land situate within the corporate limits of the City of Greenville and State aforesaid lying on the East side of Richland Street and on the West side of the Spartanburg road, and about one mile and a quarter from the Court House beginning on a stone near a small pine sapling about three feet from said pine and running thence N. 34 1/2 W. 68 chs to a stake or stone thence S. 80 1/4 East 44.25 chs to a stake said James H. Black's corner thence S. 6 1/4 E. 58.9 chs to a stake in James H. Black's line thence N. 88 1/2 West 83 links to the beginning adjoining land of John M. Jones on the West and of James H.
