Know all men by these presents that I William H Roberts of the District and State aforesaid, in consideration of Fourteen hundred dollars, to me paid by Nathan Whitwire of said District and State have granted bargained, sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Nathan Whitwire, all that piece parcel and tract of land containing two hundred and twenty three acres more or less situated lying and being in the District and State aforesaid on both sides of Langston Creek waters of Reedy River adjoining lands of length N P Bee Type Roberts, Beattie Terpin et al. and having the following lines notes and bounds viz beginning at a chestnut 3x 0m dead at the branch and running thence S 56 1/4 E 17.00 to a stone 3x 0m, formerly Spanish Oak at or near the road, thence S 84 3/8 E 28.15 to a burnt wood 3x dead and down 0m thence N 60 1/2 E 25.50 to a stone 3x 0m thence N 71 E 28.80 to a chestnut 3x 0m thence S 70 1/4 W 27.30 to a Red Oak 3x 0m cut down thence North 14.30 to an ash 3x 0m thence N 66 1/2 W 8.66 to a Sassafras 3x 3x 0m, thence S 43 W 6.90 to a sweet gum 3x 0m cut down and sweet gum 3x new thence S 26 W 1.75 to a white oak 3x 0m cut down at a branch, thence down said branch to a W O 3x 3x 0m and 3x 0m thence N 56 2/3 W 14.16 to a lightwood stake 3x 0m and stone n thence S 22 W 11.52 to a lightwood stake 3x 0m thence S 20 W 6.75 to a stone 3x n Red Oak gone and thence S 33 W 8.42 to the beginning corner all of which is more
