presents that I Richard H
Earle of Greenville County

in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Two
Thousand Dollars to me in hand paid at and before the
sealing of these presents by J. Kerne Earle of Greenville
County in the State aforesaid (the receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged) have granted bargained sold and released
and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release
unto the said J. Kerne Earle a certain tract of land situ-
ated in Greenville County & State aforesaid lying on the
waters of Big Reedy Fork Creek and hath the following
metes and bounds viz Beginning corner adjoining the lands
of Mrs. Lucinda Hopkins & Dr. W. B. Harrison & thence
running South 13.25 to a Stone corner thence East 10.80
to a Stone or P. O. thence South 23 East 3.72 to a Stone thence
South 6 1/2 East 6.23 to a Stake (P. O. witness) thence South 30 1/2
East 36.85 to a Stone thence South 30 3/4 W. 17.50 to a Pine
thence South 48 East 8.00 to P. O. thence South 70 East
8.25 to a Black Oak thence South 60 3/4 East 22.40 to a
Stone corner thence North 32 1/4 East 39.00 to a Black Gum on
the creek thence following up the creek to a Double
Beach thence North 25 East 42.35 to a Stone thence West
75.65 to the beginning corner containing three hundred
and sixty acres containing by Survey of J. Franklin
Dullwan Sept 24th 1874

the said premises before mentioned unto the said J. Kerne
Earle his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby
bind my heirs executors and administrators to warrant
and forever defend all and singular the said premises
unto the said heirs and assigns, against
myself and my heirs & every other person lawfully claiming or
to claim the same or any part thereof.
