said for and in consideration of twenty (20) Dollars to me in hand paid by Hetty Smith have granted, bargained and sold all that plantation or tract of lands lying on north side of Spartanburg road, and on waters of Cioce River containing four and a half acres more or less. Beginning at rock 3x on Spartanburg Road on Mrs F Hummetts line thence up Spartanburg road 7 chains and 12 links to Red Oak 3x on Spartanburg road, thence N 65° W 7 chains to sweet gum 3x on branch thence down branch 2 chains and 50 links to Poplar 3x on branch thence S 74° E 8 chs and 60 links to rock 3x on Mrs F Hummetts line thence S 46° E 4 chains and 25 links to beginning rock. Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining, I have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Hetty Smith her heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself and my heirs Executors administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the rights and premises before mentioned unto the said Hetty Smith her heirs and assigns against myself my heirs or any other person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
