(The receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) I have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Demarcus R Poole all that tract or parcel of land being a portion of and on the Eastern side of my Bellvue farm commencing at a Red Oak on the road from the merchant mill to said Poole's and running thence N 74° E 60 poles to a stake on Henry Beegors line thence with said line N 80° E 30 p. 15 to a maple corner of said D. R. Poole's home place; thence down the meanders of said branch S 6° E 71 p. to a Dog wood; thence downward and across said branch S 38° W 31 p. to a creek corner thence S 68° W 18 poles to the creek and thence up the creek N 35° W 17 p. to a stake; thence N 7° E 18 p. to the Black Oak (beginning) corner on the road containing twenty two acres (with the same) more or less
