Assignment

The State of South Carolina,
Greenville County. Whereas
J. D. Mock and Thomas J. Mc-
Keugh merchants and partners

trading at Greenville, South Carolina under the firm name of
Mock and McKeugh have become somewhat embarrassed and
desire to assign their stock of goods and other property in
trust for the payment of their debts as a firm as aforesaid
Therefore know all men by these presents that we the said
J. D. Mock and Thomas J. McKeugh partners as aforesaid do
each for himself and not one for the other for and in considera-
tion of five dollars to each of us paid by Walter B Gray
of the City of Greenville and for and in consideration of the
premises do with the payment of the debts due by us as a
firm as aforesaid have assigned transferred and delivered and
by these presents do assign transfer convey and deliver
unto the said Walter B Gray all of our stock of goods merch-
andise accounts choses in action and every other description of
property belonging to us as a firm as aforesaid a complete
schedule of which shall be made out within fifteen days
from date signed and attested hereto as a part of this
assignment. In trust nevertheless and to and for the uses and
purposes set forth and declared herein that is to say to sell all
of our said goods and merchandise and other property
embraced in said schedule in a reasonable time for cash
and for the best prices which can be obtained for said goods
and property in the City of Greenville. Collect our accounts
and other debts due to us appropriate the proceeds thereof to
the payment of our debts as follows - 1st by paying J. W.
W. Potts the sum of fifty Dollars for his professional
services rendered herein and to be rendered in conducting as
an attorney the winding up of the business of said firm
second by paying P. D. Guff his rent for the store house
occupied by us as a firm and thirdly by applying the
balance of the proceeds of the sale of our property and
sums collected on debts due to us to the payment of our
debts due to our other creditors pro rata giving to none of
them any preference but paying each creditor the same
percentage of his debt against us as a firm as aforesaid
And if any sum of money after all of our said debts are
paid and the expenses of winding up said business is fully
discharged it shall be paid over to us the said Mock & McKeugh
