Hawkins of the City of Greenville in the State aforesaid, am indebted to several persons, both on my own account and as a member of the late firm of Hawkins & McHugh composed of myself and Thomas S. McHugh in considerable sums of money, which I am at present unable to pay in full, and am desirous to convey all my property for the benefit of my said creditors Now therefore the said J. L. Hawkins in consideration of the premises, and of the sum of five dollars to me paid by George H. Mooney of the City and County of Greenville in said State, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained sold assigned transferred and set over and do by these presents grant bargain sell assign transfer and set over unto the said George H. Mooney, all of my goods, wares, merchandise, chattels, books of accounts, promissory notes, bills of exchange and other choses in action which I have individually and which I received from said firm of Hawkins & McHugh, at its dissolution, with my other personal property of every nature and description whatsoever, except such as is exempt from levy and sale under the laws of this State and of the United States and wherever the same may be, to have and to hold the same unto the said George H. Mooney in trust to sell and dispose of said personal property, either at public or private sale, and to collect said choses in actions of every nature whatsoever, with power to compound said choses in action, taking a part for the whole, when in his judgment it is advisable to do so, and then in trust to apply the proceeds of the said property and choses in action in the following manner to-wit: 1. To pay the law firm of Earle & Wells the sum of fifty dollars for these presents and for counsel and advice in carrying out the same, and also the lawful expense of executing the trusts hereby created 2. To pay to Mrs. Emma McHugh rent due for the store room now occupied by me and lately occupied by Hawkins & McHugh, both owing rent therefor 3. To distribute and pay</p>
