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George W Parkins to N. F. Burgess and W. W. Gilreath	Agreement	The State of South Carolina County of Greenville This memorandum of agree- ment made and entered into
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this 26th day of March A. D. 1878, between George W. Parkins
of said County and State of the first part and Nicholas F.
Burgess, and William W. Gilreath of said County and State, of
the second part, and which is intended to be supplementary
to an agreement, made and entered into by and between the said
parties on 25th May 1877, which was recorded in Book 26 No
page 667 in the office of the Register of messe conveyances of
Greenville County in said State, to which reference is hereby
made, witnesseth as follows: The said party of the first
part for and in consideration of Fifty Dollars to him paid, by
the said parties of the second part has and doth hereby
agree to let and lease to the said parties of the second part
in addition, to the lot or parcel of land leased in the agreement
of 25th May 1877, above mentioned and adjoining the same on
the West side thereof, a certain piece or parcel of land having
four feet front on Loffee Street, and running thence South,
from Loffee Street the same width, to M. T. Feas line, which
forms its northern boundary, for the full term of fifteen
years, beginning on the 1st January 1878 and ending on
the 1st January 1893 the said last mentioned piece
